New Student Admission Procedures

Thank you for your interest in Liberty Christian School. In an effort to make the admissions process a positive experience for your family, we have provided you the sequential order of steps to follow. If you have questions about any part of the admission process, please feel free to call the school office at (501) 268-4848.

Step 1 Application: Complete and sign the Admission Application. Additional applications may be obtained from the school office or online at www.libertychristianschool.net

The following items must accompany the application:

- Copy of applicant's birth certificate
- Copy of applicant's current immunization records or current exemption letter
- Copy of most recent report card/transcript
- Copy of most recent standardized test scores
- Copy of any additional special testing information, including psychological, special education testing and IEPs, if applicable.

Step 2 Interview: Once all necessary forms are received, the Principal will review the application information and then arrange for an interview with the applicant and parents/guardians. If deemed necessary by the Principal, further academic evaluation of the student may be scheduled to best determine admission acceptance. (**ALL** prospective kindergarten students will be evaluated by our kindergarten teacher to help determine kindergarten readiness.)

Step 3 Registration: Upon receipt of an admission approval by the Principal, the school secretary will call to schedule a registration appointment. The following will occur at this time:

- Payment of new student enrollment fee (non-refundable/non-transferable)
- Complete and sign Financial Policies and Agreement Form
- Discussion of textbook and school uniform orders

*Returning students must be enrolled by March 1st in order to receive the discounted enrollment fee. Returning students enrolling after the deadline will pay the new student registration fee.

Registration fees will only be refunded if denial of financial aid prevents attendance at Liberty.

TUITION ASSISTANCE LCS encourages families to apply for a reduction in tuition if needed. Qualified applicants may receive up to a 25% reduction.

Tuition Aid Data Services, an independent company, evaluates parent applications and notifies LCS if a family qualifies for assistance. Applications should be completed online at www.tuitionaid.com. There is a small application fee per family. Applications should be completed annually. Final notification of tuition assistance will be made by LCS.

MULTIPLE CHILD DISCOUNT Any additional child in the immediate family is eligible for a 10% reduction in annual tuition.

Families eligible for both Tuition Assistance and Multiple Child Discount will receive the greater reduction in tuition.

Tuition Assistance and Discounts DO NOT apply to Pre-Kindergarten students.

TEXTBOOKS and OTHER FEES

All student textbooks are purchased through LCS and must be ordered and paid for by July 1, 2017. A \$50.00 fee will be applied to orders purchased after July 1, 2017. Textbooks will be available for order on May 1, 2017.

The following fees must also be paid when textbooks are ordered:

Liberty Christian School Statement of Faith

The foundation for teaching the Word in the classroom is based on some foundational truths. LCS believes:

- 1.** The Bible to be the inspired and only infallible, inerrant, and authoritative Word of God (2 Timothy 3:15; 2 Peter 1:21).
- 2.** That there is one God, Yahweh, eternally existent as Father, Son and Holy Spirit (Genesis 1:1; John 1:1-3; John 10:30; John 14:25).
- 3.** The Deity of our Lord Jesus Christ (John 10:33), in His virgin birth (Isaiah 7:14; Matthew 1:23; Luke 1:35), in His sinless life (Hebrews 4:15; 7:26), His miracles (John 2:11); His vicarious and atoning death (I Corinthians 15:3; Ephesians 1:7; Hebrews 2:9); in His bodily resurrection (John 11:25; I Corinthians 15:4); His ascension to the right hand of the Father (Mark 16:19); and in the hope of His personal, visible future return to earth to receive to Himself His blood-bought Church that it may be with Him forever. (Acts 1:11; Revelation 19:1)
- 4.** In the precious blood of Christ, and that regeneration is absolutely essential for personal salvation because of the exceeding sinfulness of human nature; and that people are justified on the single ground of faith in the shed blood of Christ and that only by God's grace and through faith alone are we saved (John 3:16; Titus 3:5).
- 5.** In the resurrection of both the saved and the lost; they that are saved unto the resurrection of life, and they that are lost unto the resurrection of the damnation (John 5:28-29).
- 6.** In the spiritual unity of believers in our Lord Jesus Christ (Romans 8:9; I Corinthians 12:12-13; Galatians 3: 26-28).
- 7.** In the present ministry of the Holy Spirit, by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a Godly life (Romans 8:13-14; I Corinthians 3:16; 6:19-20; Ephesians 4:30; 5:18).
- 8.** In the liberty of each individual to pursue the Christ life as shown in the Scriptures, free of the guilt of sin, religious legalism and condemnation, because of the atoning blood of Jesus Christ. (Romans 8:1; Galatians 5:1, 25)
- 9.** In showing the love and compassion of Christ to all especially those in the faith. (John 15:9-17; Galatians 5:13; 6:8-10)



Financial Policies

School Year 2017-2018

Tuition is paid over a 10-month period beginning August 1st and ending May 1st, unless you choose to pay annually. Tuition may be paid by cash, check, money order, or automatic bank draft.

1. Tuition is due on the first of each month. On the 11th of each month accounts unpaid will be considered delinquent and shall be assessed a \$5.00 per student, per day late fee. If payment has not been received by the 20th of the month—including late fees, the student will not be admitted to class until payment is received.
2. Fees for hot lunch and pizza must be paid at the first of the month and cannot be charged.
3. There will be a \$25.00 charge for each returned check. If there are two returned checks in one school year, future payments must be made with cashiers checks or money orders.
4. Families with delinquent accounts will not receive report cards or transcripts until all financial obligations of LCS are paid in full.
5. Students whose parents/guardians have an outstanding obligation to LCS from a previous school year will not be permitted to start school the next year until that obligation is paid in full or a payment schedule has been worked out with the business office.
6. If circumstances beyond your control temporarily interfere with meeting your scheduled payments: submit relevant information in writing. Include dates of an alternative payment plan with specified amounts listed. This will be submitted for review to the school board. School Board decisions will be rendered by phone or letter.
